Transition Initiatives for Stabilization (TIS)-DAI announces a competitive bidding process for two construction projects in Kismayu:

- 1. Construction of Concrete Curbs along the drainage channel of the 1.3 km concrete road in Kismayu
- 2. Rehabilitation of a basketball court in Kismayu

Interested bidders must indicate in their email if they would like to receive **one or both** RFQ packages. The RFQ packages contain all information on the bidding requirements and schedule.

For both construction projects, the minimum eligibility requirements for interested bidders are as follows:

- 1. Possession of a valid, current business registration in Somalia, with preference for Jubaland.
- 2. Proof of similar types of construction work experience in Somalia within the past three years, with preference for Jubaland.

Interested bidders will be required to prove that they meet these minimum eligibility requirements <u>at the time</u> they submit their bids.

In addition, the RFQ bid package specifies other types of documentation that bidders are required to submit in order for their bids to be evaluated.

The deadline for interested bidders to request the RFQ package is 17:00 hours, 30 November 2015. Please note that beginning on 23 November, 2015, RFQ packages will be sent out on a daily basis in response to requests from interested bidders, so it is important to request the RFQ package as soon as possible prior to the deadline.
