## Organizational Background:

# **Duties and Responsibilities:**

Under the technical supervision of the Head of Beletweyne Sub-Office and the overall supervision of Mogadishu Area Coordinator, the incumbent will be responsible for the following duties:

- Coordinate the implementing partners and actively monitor progress, performance and ensure project deadlines and targets are met;
- Support and train the Training of Trainers (ToT) and farmers on the post-harvest loss (PHL) reduction and access to the markets;
- Review social and behavior change messages for broadcast using various communication channels;
- Regular engagement with smallholder farmers, producer groups and agro-dealers to ensure smooth communications and anticipate possible challenges;
- Coordinate and liaise with internal counterparts on a range of complex matters to enable effective collaboration, implementation and monitoring of ongoing project activities;
- Ensure accurate and timely recording of data within the specific technical area of work and consistency of information presented to the stakeholders:
- Provide specialized project management support to ensure technical support is provided as per the WFP's policies and procedures;
- Support the capacity building of WFP staff, cooperating partners and national government within a specific technical area;
- Perform any other related duties as required.

### Minimum Qualifications:

**Education:** Completion of secondary school education. A post-secondary certification in Agriculture, Agribusiness, Agronomy, Market Information Systems, Environmental Engineering, Food systems or other related field is desirable.

**Experience:** Five years of progressively responsible experience in programme work with a good understanding of agriculture value chain, post-harvest losses, market linkages with smallholder farmers or a field related to programme

functions in a humanitarian context is desirable.

Language: Fluency in both oral and written communication in English and Somali is a requirement.
