# Request for Bids Non-Consulting Services

1. *The Federal Republic of Somalia has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Improving Healthcare Services in Somalia (“Damal Caafimaad”) Project with Grant No IDA (D860-SO) & GFF Trust Fund (TFOB5820-SO) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Delivering Essential Package of Health Services in Nugaal Region. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank’s Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.”*
2. *The Ministry of Health and Human Services now invites sealed Bids from NGOs for delivering the essential health service package (EPHS) in Nugaal Region for a period of 24 months with following main qualification requirements:*

### Qualification Requirements

<b>Joint Ventures</b>	The information needed for Bids submitted by joint ventures is as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <i>Members must jointly meet the minimum (annual volume) requirement of \$12 million</i></li><li>- <i>At least one member must meet 80% of the requirement (Annual volume) given</i></li></ul>
<b>Annual Volume</b>	The minimum required annual volume of Services for the successful NGO in any of the last five years shall be: \$ 12 Million
<b>Experience</b>	The experience required to be demonstrated by the NGO should include as a minimum that he has executed one similar contract with amount of at least \$12 million, during the last 5 years in any or a combination of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Essential Package of Health and Nutrition Services – including:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Maternal and Newborn Health</li></ul></li></ol>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Child Health – including Immunization</li> <li>• Nutrition</li> <li>• Communicable Disease</li> <li>• Non-Communicable Diseases</li> </ul> <p>In addition, a single sub-component of EPHS also would be counted as a component. However, each component or sub-component must be related to health service delivery to population, only logistics services (i.e. supply of medicine, equipment and food) and training is not sufficient for qualification.</p> <p>b) Health Systems / Service Strengthening</p>
<b>Essential Equipment</b>	<p>The essential equipment to be made available for the Contract by the successful NGO shall be:</p> <p>Office equipment (HQ, Region, Country), computers, vehicles, generators, furniture, communication equipment, etc.</p>
<b>Key Personnel</b>	<p><i>The following are the key personnel required from the NGOs:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Project Manager (Team Leader)</li> <li>2. Technical Manager</li> <li>3. Financial Manager</li> <li>4. M&amp;E/HMIS Manager</li> <li>5. Pharmaceutical and Supply Chain Manager</li> <li>6. Social / Gender Based Violence (GBV) Specialist</li> </ol>

3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers -” November 2020 (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible NGOs as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. An NGO can only bid for maximum two regions. The NGO should include separate teams of experts and should demonstrate their technical and financial capacity to implement each Bid.
5.
