The SIDA-MIDA project is a Swedish – IOM joint initiative that aims to facilitate the transfer of skills, competencies and knowledge of qualified Somali expatriates to specific institutions within Somalia. The beneficiary institution will host the qualified Somali expatriate, and will be responsible to provide a safe and secure work environment. SIDA-MIDA will monitor the expatriate while in assignment.

III. Activities / Key Results Expected

The Somali surgeon will work in Garowe General Hospital as a general surgeon performing all surgical operations elective and emergency,, and training the local staff of the hospital.

Under the overall guidance of Dr. Abdisamad Ahmed Jama AND Garowe General Hospital, the Doctor will be responsible for the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1- To perform all surgical and medical activities in the surgery department.
- 2- To develop a plan to improve surgical and medical service of the hospital.
- 3- To organize the OT, ER and the surgery ward.
- 4- To give an advice and transfer health management skills to the hospital management.
- 5- To maintain and keep valid the surgical and medical equipments.
- 6- To keep and train the staff to the cleanness and hygiene of the work environment.

- 7- To train the department nurses and junior doctors.
- 8- To transfer surgical, medical and ethical skills to the medical students.
- 9- To maintain the medical ethics and good performance.
- 10- To do assessment of activities and monthly report to the hospital director.

Description of the assignment:

The *IOM* will be technically supporting this assignment from Nairobi through interaction with the qualified Somali expatriate and beneficiary institution

This assignment is recruiting Somali surgeon to Garowe general Hospital to improve the health service to the Somali community in Garowe city and neighbor areas, which supported by SIDA_MIDA program.

IV. Target Outputs (Measurable Results)

3-5 specific outputs; these must be clear, measurable and time bound for the project to determine success of assignment (e.g., Transfer of specific skills to beneficiary institutions civil servants).

The suspected results of the assignment will be:

- 1- Performance of >100 surgical operations in these six months.
- 2- Well trained 20persons of surgical department staff including OT, surgery ward and ER.
- 3- Improvement of the surgical department.
- 4- Transfer to the local staff how to organized and clean operation theater.
- 5- Transfer the skills of surgical ward management and patient care to the hospital staff.
- 6- Training of 2 junior doctors on the Emergency and small operations during the period.
- 7- Developing good information and data collection management system in the hospital registers and patient files.
- 8- Transfer of medical data management skills to the hospital staff.
- 9- Do 3 theorical and practical courses in the hospital to 30 hospital staff and 20 medical students.
- 10- Final report at the end of assignment and assessment of hospital staff that were trained.

V: SIDA-MIDA requirements

Besides the specific outputs mentioned in section IV, SIDA-MIDA is requiring the following steps/actions to be undertaken throughout the assignment. These are standard requirements for all assignments undertaken through this project:

- 1. Transfer of skills: One of the main responsibilities of the qualified Somali expatriate, and one which he/she will be measured against, will be to ensure continuous and systematic transfer of knowledge and skills as related to the assignment. It will have to be agreed with the beneficiary institution which civil servants will have to benefit from this knowledge.
- 2. Work plan: A work plan will have to be developed with the Supervisor during the first week of assignment which will provide clear and time bound activities to successfully implement the outputs of the assignment. This work plan will be shared with the SIDA-MIDA Project Assistant. This work plan can be revised during the mid-term review to reflect new developments or changes in strategy.
- **3. Mid Term Review:** there will be a mid-term review of the assignment between the incumbent and the beneficiary institution to discuss progress of the assignment and feedback on performance.
- **4. Interim and Final Reports:** A progress report will be submitted by the incumbent to the Supervisor and to the SIDA-MIDA Project Assistant. Thereafter a final report will be provided at the end of assignment.
