The Somalia Stabilization Initiative (SSI), locally known as 'Dalbile' aims to support Somalia's political transition to a stable federal state. The program provides stabilization assistance to communities in newly recovered areas and connects those communities to their nascent state and local governments.

The program hereby invites qualified Bidders to submit their bids (proposals) **for supply, delivery and installation of 64 Solar Street Lights according to the enclosed technical Specifications and Designs in Buurhakaba Town.**

The Terms of Reference of the project, the tendering instructions, Bill of Quantities (blank), the technical specifications and the designs for the aforementioned are enclosed with this invitation and it can be obtained as well from the IOM-SSI Office in Mogadishu and Baidoa Office, from 8:30 AM up to 3:00 PM (Sunday to Thursday).

General Conditions:

- a. **Due to the urgency of the project, this Tender is open only to suppliers who have all the materials outlined in the BOQ available in their warehouse(s) in Somalia and who can complete the work within a shorter lead time. Suppliers who will be found with no stock availability will be considered ineligible and will not be awarded the project. Stock Availability will be subject to immediate physical verification and prior to any awarding decision.**
- b. All Bids should include the firm's profile, proof of past performance/experience records on supply, delivery and installation of solar streetlight business and other relevant credentials. All bidders must provide detailed proofs of ongoing works and recently completed works with value/year of completion along with up to date list of personnel and equipment you intend to make available for this project.
- c. All bidders must provide proof of registration either from federal, regional or local authority granting them permits to perform the works and services required in this Project (more points will be awarded to local contractors). All bidders are required to conduct ocular inspection of the project site in order to gain good understanding to the project requirements and the surrounding environment of the project site which will have impact on the implementation strategy to be used in the Project.
- d. Bidders must fully comply with all documentary requirements and must submit all documents required in this instruction or any succeeding correspondence after issuance of this instruction. SSI reserve the right to reject the bid of any bidder that fails to comply with this condition.
- e. The bids to be submitted in sealed envelopes by hand delivery only to SSI Office in Mogadishu (+252612880045) on or before **25th July, 2018** not later than 10:45 AM. Late Bids will not be accepted.
- f. At the indicated time and place (**11:00 AM, 25th July, 2018**) the opening of Bids shall be carried out in the presence of the Contractors who wish to attend.

The SSI reserves the right to reject the whole or part of any or all Bids.
